Ministry Schedule

To all our volunteers who are part of our Liturgical Ministries, thank you for your participation and dedication to ensuring the sacredness of our Masses. With every weekend Mass, we count on at least 24 volunteers and, on the first weekend each month, closer to 34. Scheduling the volunteers is no easy job and has been done by volunteers over the last few years. We have now found and begun using a new electronic scheduling system, Ministry Scheduler Pro, that we hope you are finding easy to use. (We will continue to publish the schedule weekly in the bulletin and quarterly on the website and if you do not have access to a computer, you will continue to receive a paper copy.)

This system has many features that allow you to plan and access the schedule, request subs and pick up open dates. It allows the parish staff to determine if there are times when ministry positions are not being filled adequately.

Elizabeth Nowak, Director of Music and Liturgy said the system may seem difficult at first, but she thinks as people get used to the system and the information it provides it will be a success. She held two training sessions recently and will be more than happy to meet with anyone having difficulties with the systems. "Overall, I think this will be a successful change." She also hopes that with the new system people will find a substitute if they cannot be at a particular Mass when scheduled. "It makes it difficult to find a substitute the minute before Mass starts," she said.
