After completing the planning sheet, make an appointment with your wedding coordinator to review the material. Please make this appointment at least eight to ten weeks prior to your wedding date. The Director of Music and Liturgy will also be in touch with you to review/approve music and reading choices and to make sure that you have all ministries covered.
