If Baptized Elsewhere – Have NEW Baptism Certificate sent to Ann.*

Ministry Service Reflection: MAR 15

After teens have completed serving three times in the selected ministry, we ask them to complete a short reflection on their involvement. Note: The teens selected service activity should equate to at least three events and three hours of work. *Print FORM @ StVictoria.net & turn into Confirmation bin.*

Letter To Bishop: APR 4

On March 14, we will spend class time writing letters to the Bishop asking for Confirmation. After class, please spend time revising, checking spelling, and getting parent approval on a final copy which will be sent to Archbishop Hebda. *Turn into Confirmation Bin no later than Parent/Student Retreat*.
