**The readings for February 25**

Second Sunday of Lent

*Reading I:* Genesis 22:1-2; 9a, 10-13, 15-18

*Reading II:* Romans 8:31b-34

*Gospel:* Mark 9:2-10



Throughout Mark's Gospel, we hear the question "Who is Jesus?" In the transfiguration, we hear the clearest answer. But this foreshadowing of the Resurrection comes between two predictions of suffering and rejection. Even Jesus' closest apostles fail to understand what Jesus means by "rising from the dead," and they do not want to hear his predictions of his Passion. But Mark makes it clear to his audience that resurrection can only be understood in the mystery of suffering and dying.

**Question of the Week**

Has there been a time when a person turned out to be much more than you expected? Have you experienced great beauty, wisdom or courage in suffering that has stayed with you afterward and continues to move you?

**Baptism Information**

- Baptisms are celebrated on designated weekends during all three Masses and after the 5 p.m. Saturday and 10:45 a.m. Sunday Masses. **The next scheduled Baptisms will be celebrated Easter Sunday, April 1.** Baptisms are not celebrated during Lent except in an emergency. (Adults will be Baptized at the Easter Vigil on March 31.)
- You may have two sponsors (Godparents), one man and one woman, or just one sponsor. At least one sponsor must be a Confirmed, practicing Catholic and be at least 16 years old.
- Parents are required to have attended a Jordan Night (Baptism Class) within the previous five years **before** a scheduled Baptism is celebrated. The next Jordan Night is scheduled on **Thursday, April 12.**

**RCIA**

One of the distinctive truths of Catholic teaching is that the Eucharist brings into us the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus, just as he told his disciples. Yet this claim that mere bread and wine becomes the body and blood of Jesus was so controversial that many of Jesus' followers left him over it (*John 6:66*). At RCIA this week (Tuesday, February 20) we will be discussing this beautiful sacrament that we celebrate at each Mass. We will hear what Jesus said about this sacrament, explore the teachings of the early church and discuss the positions of major Protestant denominations. (Read *John 6:35-66*)

## Abstinence and Fasting

With the beginning of Lent on Ash Wednesday, Lenten abstinence and fasting begins. Abstinence means that all those age 14 and older should abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are "penitential days," a time of both abstinence and fasting. Fasting means that all those between the ages of 18 and 59 fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, eating just one full meal and two others sufficient to maintain strength, according to one's needs, but not to equal another full meal. Drinking liquids can occur between meals.
