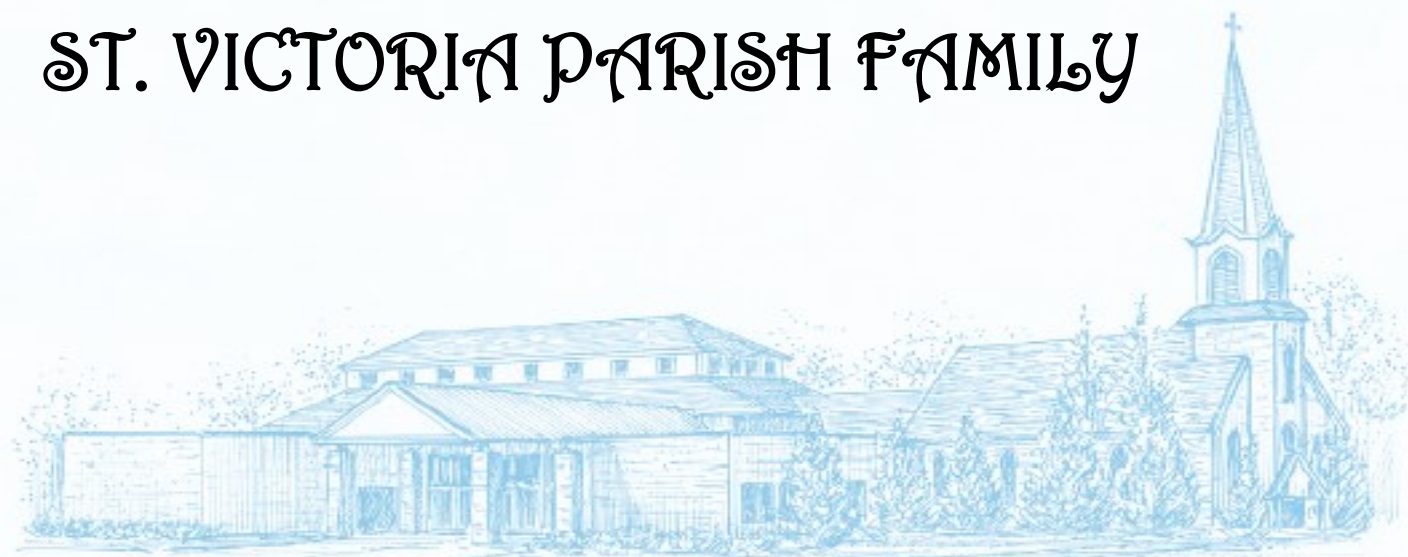

Fourteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

*Reading I:* Isaiah 66:10-14c

*Reading II:* Galatians 6:14-18

*Gospel:* Luke 10:1-12, 17-20



For centuries God's people longed for a messiah. They yearned for someone who would bring about God's reign, a time of peace and blessings. The prophets had an unshakable faith in God's reign and communicated that confidence to the people. He commissions the 72 disciples to proclaim the coming of this reign. The peace of God's reign is made possible through Jesus' life, death and resurrection. It is the fulfillment of all humanity's hopes. The disciples are successful because they are agents of God's grace. That they have been chosen as instruments of that grace is the real reason for rejoicing.

*Reading I:* Deuteronomy 30:10-14

*Reading II:* Colossians 1:15-20

*Gospel:* Luke 10:25-37



In this Gospel, two questions are addressed to Jesus by a legal expert and Jesus answers both by posing a further question. The answer to the second question takes a bit more time. Jesus tells a shocking story. The story is shocking because the Samaritans who were descended from the Jews who had intermarried with pagans, were hated by Jews. So, the good Samaritans looks after someone who despises him. After the story, Jesus poses a counter-question that really changes the original questions from "Who is my neighbor?" to "What is involved in my being a neighbor?" The reluctant answer is "The one who treated him with compassion." And Jesus says, "Then go and do the same."

### Stewardship

As we near the end of our current Stewardship Campaign (June 30) and begin our next fiscal year (July 1), we are still behind where we were last year at this time. Today, we have received 313 pledges totaling \$631,867 as compared to 386 pledges totaling \$738,177 last year. In addition, we have received 109 pledges totaling \$95,928 for debt reduction as compared to 129 pledges totaling \$103,902 in 2015. Thank you to all who have pledged — know your generosity is never taken for granted.

As we look at our budget for the coming year we are concerned because our expenses, of course, are increasing. Just as you see more expensive utilities, insurance and other expenses, St. Victoria is experiencing the same. There is still time to do whatever you can to make certain that we can continue to be the face and hands of Jesus Christ within our parish and in the community. It is with the help of each member of our parish family that we can continue as the vibrant parish we know and love. If you have not yet made a pledge, I invite you to prayerfully consider what you might be able to do to invest in our Stewardship Campaign. Remember, every little bit helps — even your prayers for a successful campaign.

I would also encourage you to enroll this year in automatic electronic giving. It's an easy way to commit to regular giving. It is convenient for you and it also allows St. Victoria to budget more effectively. Please use the pledge cards that were distributed over the last few weeks and mailed to your homes. You will find additional pledge cards in the kiosk or on our website. **Note:** Even if you are already an EFT giver, please return your pledge card.

**Reminder:** When you fill out your pledge card, be sure to include your name and other information requested. We have received several cards without names and we have been unable to update our records. If you have already made a pledge and you continued to receive letters from us, you might want to call the parish office to make certain your card had all the required information. One other reminder — new pledge and EFT amounts start July 1. Thank you!
