**Strength of the Saints Relic Tour**

The relics of two saints who exemplified courage and conviction in the face of persecution are coming to the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis. St. Thomas More and St. John Fisher were prominent 16th Century Englishmen who stood against King Henry VIII and his attempted supremacy over the Catholic Church and accepted martyrdom instead of abandoning their faith. This fearless witness is especially compelling to American Catholics today, as we face threats to our religious liberty and rights of conscience. Relics of the saints will be available for veneration at the **Cathedral of St. Paul on Sunday, June 26, 6:30 to 8 p.m.** The relics will also be traveling to Cloquet, Bemidji, St. Cloud, New Ulm and Rochester. The tour is being organized by the Minnesota Catholic Conference and is part of the broader Fortnight for Freedom, a call to fourteen days of prayer, education and action for religious freedom in the United States and abroad. ## Stewardship

As we enter the week six of our Stewardship campaign, I have to tell you that I am concerned that we are significantly behind this year. At this point last year, we had 322 pledges totaling \$636,518. This year we have 272 pledges totaling \$553,017. In addition, last year we had 116 pledges for debt reduction totaling \$90,342 and this year we have 95 totaling \$84,568.

If you have already made a pledge for stewardship and/or debt reduction, thank you. Your generosity is always deeply appreciated.

I know this is a busy time of year with Confirmations, graduations and preparing for summer vacations, so remembering to fill out your pledge card might just be one more thing on your "to do" list and it just slipped your mind. Perhaps you can put a reminder on your refrigerator about this important detail — we do need your help if we are to meet our financial obligations and fulfill our ministries.

If you haven't filled out your pledge card yet, I encourage you to enroll in electronic giving. It's an easy way to commit to regular giving. It is convenient for you, but it also allows St. Victoria to budget more effectively. Please use the pledge cards that have been handed out the last few weeks and mailed to your homes or you will find additional pledge cards in the kiosk or on our website.

Reminder: When you fill out your pledge card, be sure to include your name and other information requested. We have received several cards without names and we have been unable to update our records. If you have already made a pledge and you are continuing to receive letters from us, you might want to call the parish office to make certain your card had all the required information. One other reminder — new pledge and EFT amounts start July 1.
