Fourth Sunday of Lent

Reading I: Joshua 5:9, 10-12

Reading II: 2 Corinthians 5:17-21

Gospel: Luke 15:1-3, 11-32



The parable of the prodigal son is one of the best known of all the stories Jesus told. The parable is about divine mercy and the desire “to return to the father.” Luke has in mind tax collectors and sinners who were “drawing near” to Jesus. The group of Pharisees and Scribes, represented by the elder son, only complain and criticize. According to the way they see it, they have served God and obeyed the law. They don’t understand how sinners can also be sons and daughters of God. For Luke, the religious leaders who keep all the rules and think they can earn salvation by their own efforts are farther away from God than the sinners.

**Question of the Week**

Was there a time when you were away from God? How did you find your way back? What brought you back? How did you feel?

**Baptism Information**

- The next scheduled Baptisms are Easter Sunday, March 27. Baptisms will be celebrated during the 8:45 and 10:45 a.m. Masses and after the 10:45 a.m. Mass. There may be adult Baptisms celebrated at the Easter Vigil Liturgy. (Baptisms are not celebrated during Lent except in an emergency.) In April, Baptisms will be celebrated the weekend of April 9 and 10.
- Baptisms are celebrated during all three weekend Masses and after the 5 p.m. Saturday and 10:45 a.m. Sunday Masses.
- You may have two sponsors (Godparents), one man and one woman or just one sponsor. One sponsor must be a Confirmed, practicing Catholic and they must be at least 16 years old.
- Parents are required to have attended a Jordan Night within the previous five years **before** a scheduled Baptism is celebrated. The next Jordan Night (Baptism class) is **Thursday, March 10.**

**24 Hours for the Lord**

Whether it has been weeks, months, years or decades, Pope Francis wants all to come back to confession. In announcing his “24 Hours for the Lord” initiative, he said, “Let us place the Sacrament of Reconciliation at the center once more in such a way that it will enable people to touch the grandeur of God’s mercy with their own hands.” In response to his call, every diocese in the world will hold around-the-clock confessions from **Friday, March 4, to Saturday, March 5.** Here in the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis, the Basilica of St. Mary and the Cathedral of St. Paul will start the 24 hours with prayer and confession services for priests from noon to 1:30 p.m. on Friday and then confessions for the faithful at both locations beginning at 1:30 p.m. on Friday and ending at noon on Saturday. ## Baptismal Certificate Reminder

As a reminder for all First Eucharist and Confirmation (10th Grade) Parents: We **must** have a Baptismal Certificate signed and dated from the parish where your child received the sacrament of Baptism. Please remember that it must come from the parish, we cannot accept a copy you may have at home. It must be dated within six months of the sacrament your child will be receiving this spring. If your child was baptized at St. Victoria, we will have all the information we need. **Please do not wait until the last minute to contact parishes for these certificates — it is not always possible to have the certificate prepared and signed in just a day or two.** Please call me with any questions.

As we enter into the Lenten Season, we become very aware that the sacrament season is in full swing at St. Victoria. Our second-year Confirmation students will be Confirmed on May 22, our RCIA candidates will be fully initiated in the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil and our First Sacrament students will receive First Communion on April 30 and May 1.
