



So resounding is its message that echoed of the Exodus are heard throughout the Old and New Testaments and the present. Exodus names and terms permeate our biblical and liturgical vocabularies: Pharaoh, Moses, Aaron, burning bush, "I AM", plagues, Passover, manna, Ten Commandments, forty days and forty nights, Ark of the Covenant. The Exodus experience, ended, if central to both Jewish and Christian traditions. Exodus is not only an ancient text but also today's story, calling readers to participate in a covenant relationship with one another and God. With this bible study, participants will march through this basic book of the Bible with the sacred text aligned on either side, like a wall to their right and left, just as the Israelites "marched on the dry land through the midst of the sea with the water like a wall to their right and their left" (14:29). Hopefully, when finished, participants in this adult bible study will be closer to the Promised Land than when they started.
