### The Journey

We've all been journeying 40 days in preparation for the Easter celebration. We have been praying, giving alms and fasting. There's a small group here at St. Victoria, and a larger group worldwide, who have been preparing much longer. Our three RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) candidates and one catechumen have been journeying since the first part of October.

Through the year they have attended weekly RCIA sessions with various topics from sacraments to morality and scripture to saints. At the beginning of Advent, they participated in the Rite of Acceptance and Welcome (welcoming them into the Order of Candidates and Catechumens in preparation for reception into the full Communion of the Catholic Church). At the beginning of Lent, their journey took them to the Basilica for the Rite of Election/Sending (to join other RCIA candidates and catechumens from the Archdiocese). On three successive Sundays in Lent, the participants participated in the Scrutiny Rites (oriented toward inner spiritual awakening and repentance), modeling the way for our own Lenten journey. During the first scrutiny they were presented with the Creed and at the third scrutiny with the Lord's Prayer. After participating in the Triduum Liturgy during Holy Week, the destination and beginning of their journey is the Easter Vigil when they were received into Full Communion with Baptism for those not previously Baptized and with Confirmation and Communion for each of them.

The final phase of RCIA is a time when the new Catholics prayerfully consider what God has for them next, whether it is through their prayer life, participation in ministries or a different journey.

I am pleased to introduce our **Catechumen Michael Lowden** (with his sponsor Patrick McKinney) and **Candidates Amy Walsh** (with her sponsor Patrick Walsh), **Colin Faust** (with his sponsor Rudy Borowice) and **Kevin Kolle** (and his sponsor Becky Kolle).

We also welcomed three children who prepared for their Easter sacraments by attending Faith Formation and additional meetings with their parents, Tom and Laura Kahlbaugh. They are **Cole** (sponsors Jim and Karen Drake), **Emmett** (sponsor Carole Verkinderen) and **Ella** (sponsor Karen Drake). In addition, we had the honor of blessing **Tom and Laura's marriage**.

## Scholarship Requests

Requests for scholarships are now being accepted from active St. Victoria parishioners who have been registered members of St. Victoria for at least six months and who do not otherwise qualify for a tuition discount or subsidy by reason of also being a member of the host school's parish. Parents who qualify may submit a scholarship request (found on the parish website) annually to request tuition assistance for children who are enrolled in Grades 1 through 8 in a neighboring Catholic School for the coming year. **All completed request forms must be received by Deacon Ray in the parish office before June 1, 2018, to be considered for scholarship aid for the 2018/2019 school year. To facilitate budgeting requirements, no late scholarships requests will be considered.** All scholarships will be disbursed, in equal amounts (as funds allow) directly to the school on a quarterly basis, provided students remain enrolled.
